【第3問題】

次の英文を読み、あとの問1~問6に答えなさい。 (*のついている単語や語句には本文のあとに〈注〉があります。)

We can't live without water. We can live for more than a month without food, but we can live for only a few days without water. So, (1) some people say that water is more important than food to be healthy. Moreover, water is used for various things. We use water when we cook. Vegetables are sometimes *boiled in water, and ①[____] to grow. Farmers must also give water to the animals they *raise. Without water, people cannot eat chicken, beef, pork, or other meat. Water is also needed in some factories. For example, paper factories need a lot of water to make paper.

②By the way. [____]? You may think that water comes from the sky, rivers, and so on. Actually, water comes from forests. In Japan, it rains a lot, and many trees *store rainwater. Their *roots go down into the ground, and when it rains, they *take in the rainwater and that makes the ground *firm. In other words, (2) forests are like dams. Forests keep water and *turn it into clean water through the ground. And then, they *release it into the rivers little by little.

These days, people around the world have the problem of global warming. (3) The number of natural disasters, such as heavy rain, is increasing in Japan because of global warming. Heavy rains cause other problems, too. If it rains heavily, *floods will happen and damage houses near rivers. In mountain areas, there may be more *landslides.

What is (4)the main reason for these problems? Some scientists say that it is *deforestation. For a long time, people have cut down trees or destroyed mountains and have built many houses to live in those areas. Or, in some areas, people put up a lot of *solar panels. The leaves of trees *absorb *carbon dioxide and release *oxygen. However, because people cut down so many trees, the amount of carbon dioxide in the air is increasing more and more. That is one of the causes of global warming. Moreover, if we have fewer trees in forests, they won't be able to keep much water when it rains, and it will go directly into the river. As a result, damage from floods and landslides will increase.

If we don't act and try to solve these problems, we will suffer from more floods and other water problems in the future and won't be able to live peaceful lives. Forests and water *are closely related to each other, so it is important to protect forests to solve water problems.
